AUXILIARY RULES AND GUIDELINES

The following rules and guidelines are provided to clarify the auxiliary competition. These guidelines are to be observed by all participating units.

1. Auxiliary entries will use MSHSAA classifications.
2. Each unit must have at least 3 members to compete.
3. Performing groups are scheduled in 7-minute time slots which includes entering, performing, and exiting.
4. The performance area will be a regulation size basketball court. No specific warm-up area is available. Enter for performance from the WEST side of the gym and exit to the EAST.
5. Competition will begin with the introduction of your group over the public address system.
6. Music can be on a cd, mp3 device with auxiliary jack input, or bluetooth. If you need an iPhone plug to 1/4" jack you must bring your own. The cd should be marked with the name of your school clearly identified.
7. In order to protect the gym floor, the following padding regulations must be observed by all groups: (Groups not in compliance will not be allowed to perform) - all flag poles must have crutch tips on both sides. - all rifles must be padded at both ends of the equipment. - all shoes must be soft, non-marking.
8. One or Two judges, if possible, will be used for auxiliary evaluation.
9. Auxiliary units may participate for "critique only" if they do not wish to compete.
10. There will be three trophies awarded in each class.

DRUM LINE RULES & GUIDELINES

Included in this information are the rules and guidelines for the drum line competition. These guidelines are to be observed by all participating units.

1. Indoor drum line entries will use MSHSAA classifications.
2. A drum line must consist of at least 3 members.
3. Performing groups are scheduled in 7-minute time slots which includes entering, performing, and exiting.
4. Competition will begin with the introduction of your drum line over the public address system.
5. The performance area will be a regulation size basketball court. No inside warm-up area will be available. Enter for performance from the WEST side of the gym and exit to the EAST.
6. Drum lines will perform with percussion instruments only, use of a horn line or auxiliary units will not be permitted. Exception: Electric Bass, Keyboard, and Guitar
7. In order to protect the gym floor, the following padding regulations must be observed by all groups: (Groups not in compliance will not be allowed to perform) All instrument stands must have rubber tips on the legs or rubber wheels if rolling stands are used. All shoes must have soft, non-marking soles.
8. Two judges, if possible, will be used for evaluation, one for musical performance and the other for general effect.
9. Drum lines may participate for "critique only" if they do not wish to compete.
10. There will be three trophies awarded in each class.
